DEADLINE FOR APPLICATIONS EXTENDED.
Mesa Arts Center Foundation is accepting applications for the
***Arts at the Center* program through September 19, 2022.**

Mesa, AZ - The Mesa Arts Center Foundation's *Arts at the Center* program is extending the deadline to accept Letters of Interest for the 2022-2023 season. *Arts at the Center* grants provide support to educational and non-profit organizations for the use of Mesa Arts Center ("MAC") spaces, including its beautiful world-class theaters.

The deadline to submit a Letter of Interest to request *Arts at the Center* support this cycle has been extended to Monday, September 19 at 5 p.m. Those accepted to submit full applications will be notified on October 7, 2022 and sent a short application which must be returned by October 25, 2022. Award notifications will be sent out by November 1, 2022.

Up to six *Arts at the Center* grant recipients are chosen each year to present a performance or activity on one of MAC's stages or in one of its other spaces (studios, outdoor spaces). Theater seating can accommodate from 100 to 1,500 attendees, depending upon the selected space and the type and size of the presentation.

"We are pleased to be able to make access to the beautiful spaces at Mesa Arts Center available to organizations who might otherwise not have the opportunity to perform there. We encourage organizations who haven't previously applied to consider doing so, as we'd love to welcome them to Mesa Arts Center. The MAC Foundation is proud to offer a way for both established and grassroots arts organizations to inspire and celebrate with the community" said Dennis Kavanaugh, Arts at the Center committee chair.

An *Arts at the Center* Grant allows presenters to waive the facility's rental fee and receive up to \$1,000 in financial support to offset Mesa Arts Center production costs.

Past grant recipients include Phoenix Boys Choir, Grey Box Collective, Ballet Folklorico Quetzalli, Alice Cooper's The Rock Teen Center-Proof is in the Pudding, The Arizona School for the Arts and Harmony Project.
